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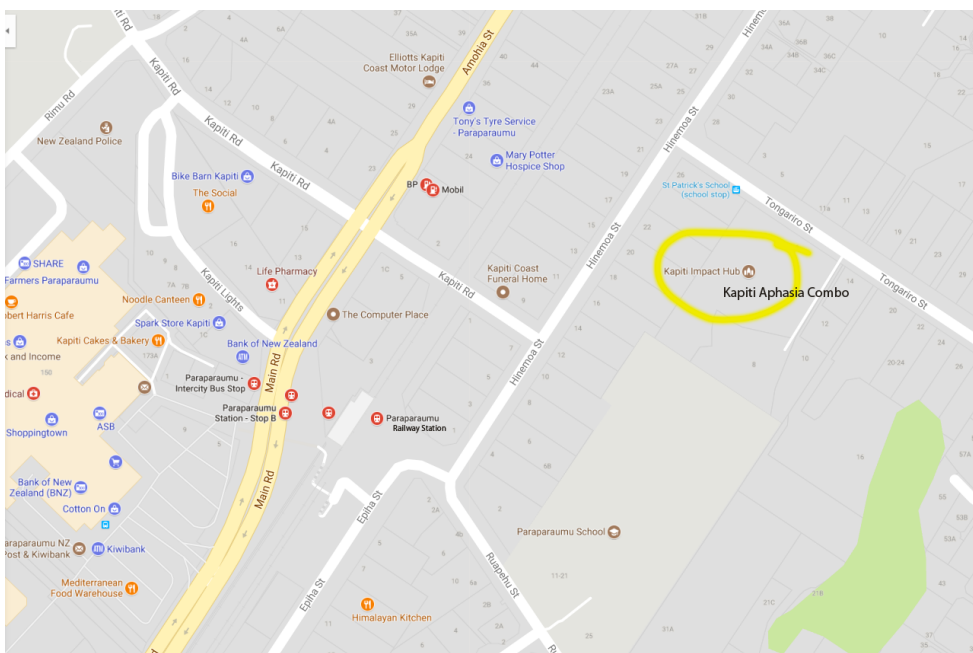
Kapiti Aphasia Combo is a group dedicated to **connecting with others** with aphasia and their supporters, and to **increase confidence** in communicating.
