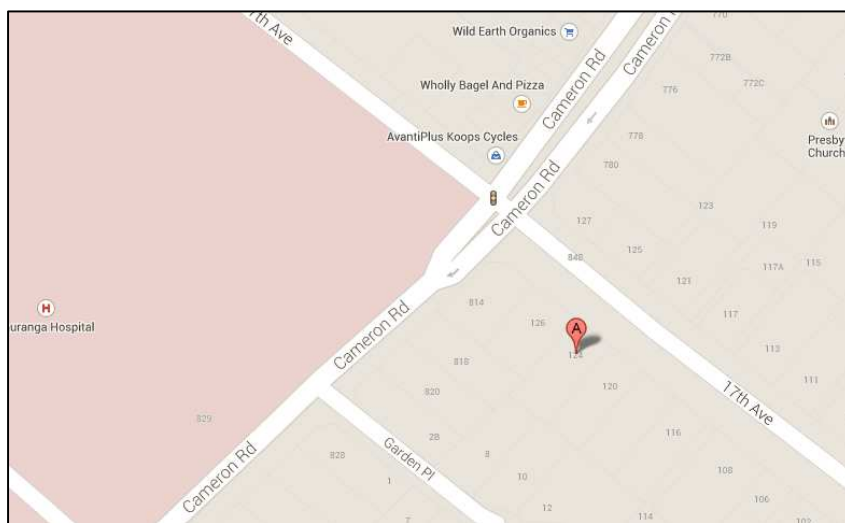


# The Brain Wave Singers

Led by Robin Matthews - Speech & Language Therapist with the fabulous support of Pianist Fred Chell, the choir includes a series of voice and breathing exercises to help you maintain good vocal function.

Research reveals compelling evidence that singing can help voice and breathing in people with Parkinson's and help to 'rewire' the brain after injury, and so could help with conditions like aphasia.



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
