## THE DIFFERENCE WE ARE MAKING

Over **1100** people with aphasia receiving support at any one time.

**522** group meetings held around New Zealand with **4438** attendances.

**165** online group meetings held with **1201** attendances – Kōrero Clubs and support groups.

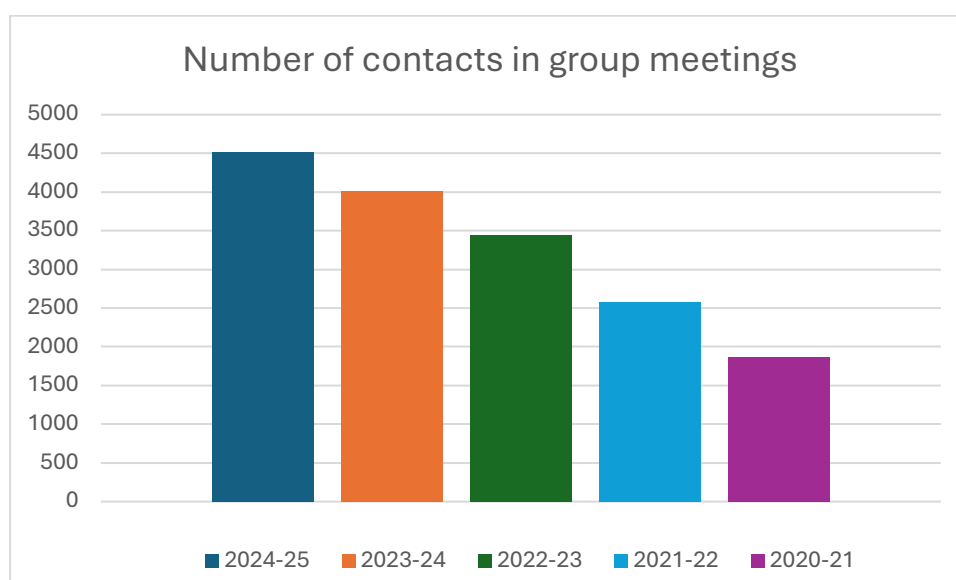
**6150** contacts made with people with aphasia, family members and those working with aphasia

**42** workshops and events providing education to around **1000** attendees.

**1100** contacts providing individual support for people with aphasia and whānau

**41** iPad loans to people with aphasia for therapy support – an increase of **30%** on last year.
